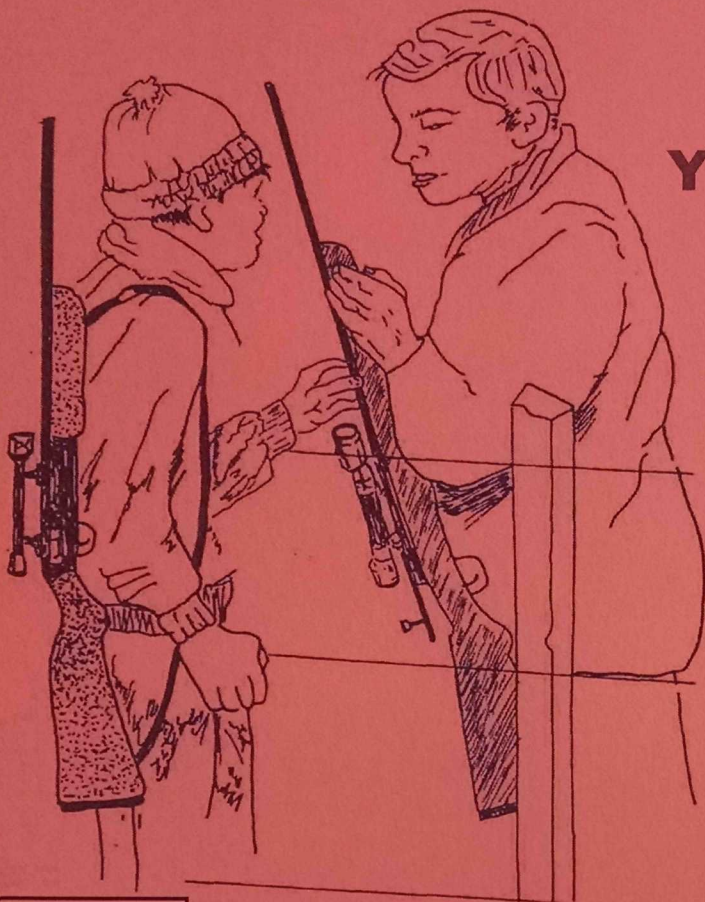


# LEARN TO HANDLE FIREARMS THE RIGHT WAY

## Enroll in a Hunter Education Course

### KNOW YOUR FIREARM AND YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES!



All Montana residents born after January 1, 1985 are required to show proof of completing a Hunter Safety & Education Course prior to applying for or purchasing any hunting license.

A certificate is issued only to persons having successfully completed a firearms safety course.

#### ATTENDANCE REQUIRED AT ALL 5 CLASSES & FIELD COURSE TO CERTIFY

**A parent or guardian must accompany student(s) to registration to sign form.**

You may register early online at <http://fwp.mt.gov/education/hunter/> (OPTIONAL). However, you must still show up at the school during registration/orientation for parents/guardians to sign release form and to pick-up materials for the class.

**All Registrations are Mandatory – If you don't register, you can't take the class**

Youth hunters **MUST** turn 12 years old by January 16 of the following year in order to take the course. Eleven year old hunters may hunt the previous fall if they turn 12 by January 16 with completion of a hunter safety and education course.
