All of the 7th and 8th grade math students are invited to participate in a statewide math competition. This will take place February 26 at Senior High School from 4:30 p.m. to approximately 6:30 p.m. The students wishing to participate will be picked up and returned to Lockwood School by bus.

The competition consists of three test type sessions. Each student will be scored individually and his/her score may be used for a team or school score for local competition. The individual score will then be sent on for state competition. Rewards may include possible math extra credit points or assignment passes and depending on placement, individual recognition and school recognition.

The cost to participate in the contest is \$3.00. At the contest, concession stands will be set up for students to purchase snacks between sessions.

The deadline for sign up is February 8. However, the sooner we complete the sign-up the better for reserving buses and number of spots for contest.

We are also asking for parent volunteers. For every ten students that participate we will need one adult. Volunteers are asked to be at Senior High Library by 4:00 p.m. If you are interested in volunteering please sign below and have your child return to his/her math teacher.

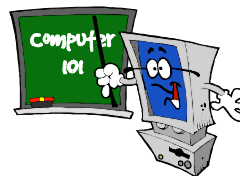

The Lockwood School website at www.lockwood-school.org is mobile and tablet friendly. The site adjusts to the screen size of the device that is being used and phone numbers are functional so the user can call a number directly from the phone. Links to Lockwood's several social media accounts, such as the school and PTA Facebook pages, as well as the various school Twitter and Instagram accounts, are now available in the top navigation bar of all main areas of the site.

Drop-down navigation menus are available at the top of each main sector of the site.
