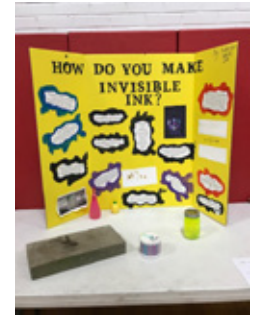

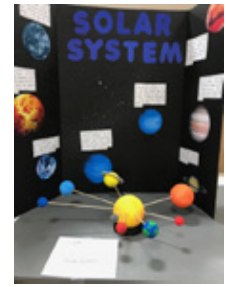
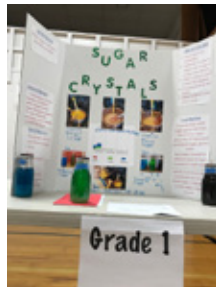

With this in mind, Lockwood PTA is excited to be coordinating a readathon event for our K-5 students! We are encouraging Lockwood students to make a personal reading goal & if they choose, to also collect pledges for them. While asking for pledges, explain the readathon is to inspire a long term joy for reading & encourage families & students to be proactive together about reading, and to help raise funds for the school. They can pledge a one time amount, or amount per reading block.

***READING BLOCKS WILL VARY DEPENDING ON THE GRADE LEVEL OF CHILD:
Grades K-2 will require 10 minutes of reading each "block" and Grades 3-5 blocks will require 20 minutes of reading each.
