The competition consisted of three test type sessions. Each was student scored individually. The individual score on each session was used to determine the rating of each participant as being either Superior (highest rank), Honorable Mention, or Participant. The scores will be sent on to be a part of the state competition.

The students represented Lockwood very well. Completing a total of 21 sessions, the students earned 9 Honorable Mention ratings and 12 Participant ratings. Nice job to the participating students and to all the teachers who teach math in our district.
